

**Town of Pleasant Valley
 Eau Claire County, Wisconsin
 Ordinance No. 15-15-01
 Chapter 5 - Licenses and Permits
 Establish Alcohol License Fees**

Whereas, Sec 125 of Wis Statutes authorizes the establishment of license fees related to the dispensing of alcoholic beverages within the Town of Pleasant Valley;

Now, Therefore the Town Board of the Town of Pleasant Valley, Eau Claire County does ordain as follows:

1. FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES.

Class “A” beer license (per 125.25(4)) (Consumption off premises)	\$25.00
Class “B” beer license (per 125.26(4)) (Consumption on and off premises)	\$100.00

2. INTOXICATING LIQUOR

“Class A” liquor license (per 125.51(2)(d)) (Consumption off premises)	\$250.00
“Class B” liquor license (per 125.51(3)(e)) (Consumption on and off premises) Quota (2)	\$500.00
Reserve “Class B” liquor license (per 125.51(3)(e)2) (Consumption on and off premises) Quota (3)	\$10,000.00
Special “Class B” Winery License (per 125.51(3)(f) and (am)) (Consumption on and off premises) Does not apply to quotas (per 125.51(4)1)	\$500.00
“Class C” wine license (per 125.51(3m)(e)) (Consumption on premises only)	\$100.00

3. PRORATION OF LICENSE FEES

Class “A” beer, “Class A” liquor, “Class B” liquor, Class “B” beer Special “Class B” Winery and “Class C” wine, when a new license is issued, a prorating of the annual license fees shall be made on the basis of the number of months or fraction thereof remaining in the licensing year which is July 1 to June 30.

4. OTHER LICENSES

Temporary Class “ B ” (Picnic) beer license (per 125.26(6)) (To “bona fide) clubs per 125.26(6) and 125.51(10)	\$10.00
Operator license (Bartender)(125.17(3)) (Issued annually July1 to June 30)	\$15.00
Provisional license (Bartender)(per 125.17(5)) (Valid for period not to exceed 60 days)	\$10.00
Temporary Operators license (Bartender)(per 125.17(4)) (Valid for any period from 1 to 14 days)	\$5.00

5. PRORATION OF OTHER LICENSES FEES.

There is no prorating of the new other licenses fees (Section No. 4).

6. SEVERABILITY

All other ordinances or parts of other ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with this ordinance.

7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall go into effect beginning with July 1, 2015 licenses issued upon its proper publication pursuant to law.
